They are Lahu tribe .There are 269 peoples from 68 families. 14 families are Christian and 54 families are Buddhist. They all are farmers. They plant rice, corn, mango, banana and raise cows. They need the water for drink and cleaning.

The total distance are 3,540 meters, we put faucet for 6 spots in village, built the bathroom for 10 families. We did the training for water system management, cleaning soap and gardening.
